Individual Safari Rates

- ▶ **Safari** – Involves driving and some walking—2 1/2-3 hours long. Rate: \$68 for adults/teens; \$30 for children (ages 3-12); \$10 for infants (ages 1-2). Group Rates (20 or more) — \$10 off adult/teen rate; \$5 off child rate.
- ▶ **Private Safaris** – Private Wine and Cheese Safari, Photo Safari, and Cheetah and Chardonnay Safari. These special tours start at \$650 for up to 10 guests.

Tour times:

Spring through Fall—9 AM, 1 PM, and 4 PM
Winter tours—10 AM and/or 2 PM

All tours are weather dependent. Please call ahead during inclement conditions to reconfirm tours.

Cheetah and Behind-the-Scenes Activities
